Dear Residents and Family Members

In the last few hours before Pesach we want to share an update with you so that you can go into yomtov with peace of mind.

Thank G-d, all is well on our campuses. Life continues normally for our residents who are in good spirits. Please follow the Chev's Facebook posts to see reassuring and positive messages from residents and from management about what is happening onsite.

We have been in lockdown since March 13th and have implemented stringent safety and security measures to keep our residents and staff well. Hygiene and cleaning protocols have been heightened, requiring the hiring of additional staff and intensive training.

Face masks have been distributed to all staff who are checked for temperatures and flu-like symptoms at the security entrance every time they arrive at work to ensure they are free of symptoms. We have ensured that we have adequate stocks of cleaning materials, sanitisers and personal protective clothing (PPE) for our doctors, nurses and care givers.

Every responsible precaution has been taken to protect our residents. Please rest assured that if someone should G-d forbid become unwell, families will be contacted immediately.
